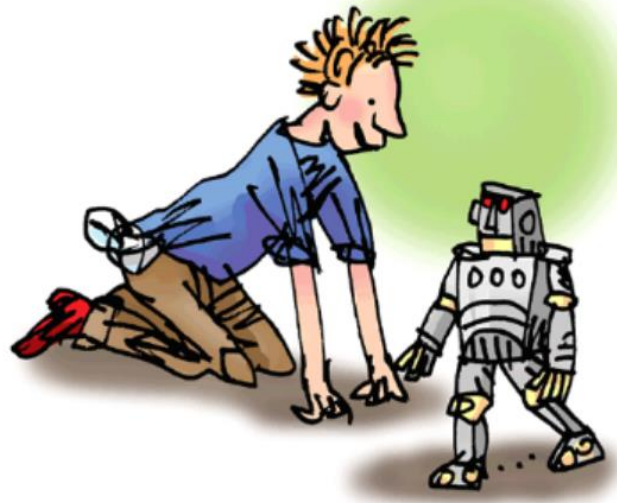



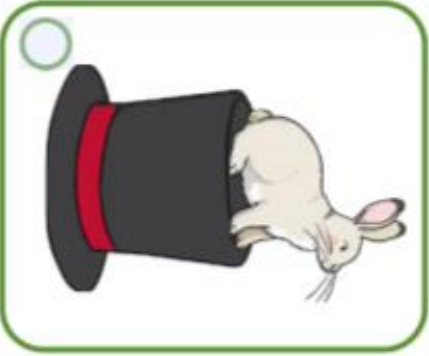
Roll a dice and read all the words for that number. If you don't have a dice make number cards 1-6. Lay them face down and turn one over to choose a number.

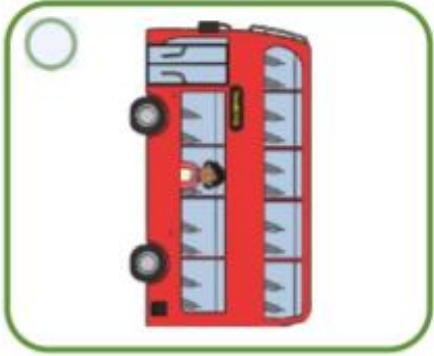
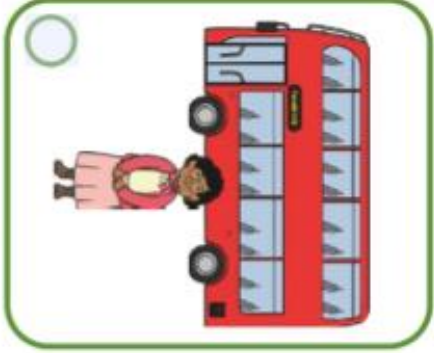
