

Set 1 sounds - 9:30-10:00 repeated at 12:30-1:00 <u>Set 2 sounds</u> - 10:00-10:30 repeated at 1:00-1:30 <u>Set 3 sounds</u> - 10:30-11:00 repeated at 1:30-2:00

Recount activity

Watch $\underline{\text{https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=ReOpCqUZu9w}}$ to find out about recounts. Think about something you did over the holidays or something you have done in the past that you found really exciting or interesting. It could be about finding out you couldn't go to school for a while!

Draw what happened. It could be one picture, a timeline or like a story map. You could add some words or phrases that you think would be good to use in your recount

Using your pictures, write your recount. Don't forget to tell us what happened, when it happened and how you felt. You also need to write in the past tense. When you have finished, read it through to check it makes sense. Have you remembered your capital letters, full stops and maybe even some exclamation marks?
