Daily English...

Please continue to watch the phonic videos.

If you have been watching the videos from the start of home learning, you may find the sounds starting to repeat. If this is the case, please move on to the next set.

Set 1 sounds - 9:30 repeated at 12:30 **Set 2 sounds** - 10:00 repeated at 1:00
Set 3 sounds - 10:30 repeated at 1:30

Don't forget to **read** for 15/20 minutes a day using books from these 2 websites. These books are the same colours you brought home from school. Please email your teacher if you are unsure what colour your child should have. Read the book a couple of times to help improve their fluency and talk about what happened, who the characters were, the setting and how the characters may have been feeling.
