We have been retelling the story, making our own puppets, designed our own bird and


then made plans for how we can catch it. Our key vocab has been; tiptoe, paddling, climbing, slowly.

We have loved exploring a favourite book of ours; "Room on the Broom".

We have been acting out the story, creating our own beast characters, re-telling and writing our own version of the story and designing a new broom stick.

Our key vocab has been; fluttered, clutched, squelched, shrieked and ditch.

In <u>Maths</u> we have been exploring and embedding our numbers to 20 and then 50.; We have been comparing using symbols, finding tens and ones, practising careful counting and representing these numbers using resources.

The children have settled brilliantly into Year 2 and are being great models in terms of behaviour and work ethic. We are extremely proud of the work they are producing and the efforts they are making!




