

Nursery Learning Autumn 2019

Physical Development

- Gain control in holding and using tools, such as pens, scissors and jugs for pouring.
- Say when I need to use the toilet or when I need my nappy changing.
- Know how to use the climbing equipment safely.
- Know that it is important to wash my hands after using the toilet and before I eat.

Communication and Language

- Listen to short stories with interest.
- Use my words to tell others what I want/need.
- Join in with familiar songs and rhymes.
- Talk to other children in my play.
- Understand 'who', 'what' and 'where' questions.

Personal, Social and Emotional Development

- Play alongside other children and begin to join in.
- Say goodbye to my parent/carer and settle to an activity.
- Try out new activities.
- Know the nursery rules - be ready, be kind, be safe.
- Know the nursery routine.

Understanding the world

- Talk about my friends and family.
- Begin to build up stories with small world toys.

Expressive Arts and Design

- Experiment with musical instruments.
- Join in with familiar songs and rhymes
- Take part in pretend play.

Literacy

- Repeat words or phrases from known stories and songs.
- Experiment with mark making.

Maths

- Recite some number names in order from nursery rhymes.
- Use language of 'more'.
